

Synopsis

Rita, sons Ben and Michael, and Michael's girlfriend Sandi returning home after visiting Sy Finberg's grave upon the second anniversary of his death. While Rita goes to change, Ben and Michael tell Sandi stories about their father. Back in California, Ben calls Michael and asks him to come. There Ben informs Michael he's being charged for Medicare fraud. A series of flashbacks reveal how one of their father's best friends and president of a synagogue, Norm Singer, asked Ben to falsify medical reports so he could pocket the reimbursement to maintain his highflying lifestyle. Though reluctant, Ben agrees. The FBI comes to investigate. Ben soon informs Norm, who plays ignorant leading Ben to speculate that Norm set him up.

After visiting Ben in prison, Michael visits Norm Singer, who admits setting Ben up so as not to learn of Norm's embezzlement of synagogue funds. Upon release from prison, Ben, Michael, and Rita meet and reminisce when the entire family would meet at a restaurant. Sy appears, and they recreate a scene Ben described earlier in the play.
